

## UNITED AIRLINES MAINTENANCE CONTROLLERS NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE – 06/24/2021

Dear Members,

The Company and the Union just completed another bargaining session which began Tuesday, and ended today June 24, 2021. The Company opened by passing five Articles for discussion. The Articles included: Scope, Compensation, Benefits, Hours of Service, and Vacation/Holiday. This pass from the company brought the talks back into the economics of the agreement. The Union took the remainder of the day Tuesday and most of Wednesday to give a response. Our response reiterated the point that we need pay parity within the industry and a pay scale based on years of service. Thursday's session ended with the Union's latest economic pass on the table.

The next scheduled dates are July 27<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup>. We are down to a select number of economic issues at this point, and are hopeful we will be able to reach a tentative agreement over the course of the summer.
