We are currently offering COVID-19 first dose and booster shots as well as flu shots by appointment.

Booster Shot Information

There are now booster recommendations for all three available COVID-19 vaccines in the United States. Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose. CDC's recommendations are now allowed for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.

For individuals who received either the **Pfizer or Moderna vaccine**, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot 6 months or more after their initial series (prior to May 3, 2021):

- 65 years and older
- Age 18+ who live in a long-term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who work in high-risk settings
- Age 18+ who live in high-risk settings

For individuals who received the **Johnson & Johnson vaccine**, booster shots are recommended for those who are 18+ and were vaccinated two or more months ago (prior to September 3, 2021)

Vaccines Offered

We will offer Pfizer and Moderna at this clinic. We are working to secure the Johnson & Johnson vaccine for the single initial dose and booster shots. If you are looking for J&J, you are welcome to register now and indicate that you want J&J. We will let you know as it gets closer if we will be able to provide the vaccine. If you received J&J initially, you may switch to either Pfizer or Moderna for your booster shot.

Flu Shot Information

Flu shots are available for ages 3+.

Additional Information

Please bring:

- A government issued ID
- Your health insurance card
- If this is a booster shot, bring your CDC vaccination card

Note: flu shot recipients are required to present proof of health insurance or pay the on-site copay.
